

Responsibility Worksheets for Kindergarten

- Give your kid a particular room or space, so he feels responsible, and ask him to take control of things by maintaining them.
- Model the positive behavior that you want to teach your kids.
- Set a good example and tell your kids that every action has a reaction and consequences so that they feel the need to be responsible.
- Teach them to speak up for their rights.
- Share your tasks and hold them accountable if anything goes wrong.
- Teach your kids to move on and Learn from their mistakes.
- Teach your kids always to clean up their mess.
- Help your children with complex tasks.
- Give small tasks to your children to make them accountable.
- If your child has damaged something, ask them to repair those ties or at least mend the things.
- Don't call names or label your child mean names.
- Give your child age-appropriate tasks.
- Tell your child about his efforts, not the results.
