Clean up their room twice a week	Let them choose dinner a few nights a week	Help mom or dad change the clothes in the washer and dryer	Help set the table at dinner time	Put their own lunchbox in their backpack each morning	Help water the flowers
Help bake cookies, cupcakes, cakes, etc.!	Help siblings with their chores	Organize their toy bin	Make their bed each morning	Feed the family pet at dinner time	Help fold their own laundry, specifically smaller items like socks
Make a bathing schedule	Help dry the dishes	Put dirty clothes in the hamper	Help bring in the mail	Keep their shoes in one spot in the house	Help put away groceries
Brush their teeth and hair each morning	Go to the bathroom before leaving the house	If five years old, they can order their own food at a restaurant	Say please and thank you when asking for something	Turn off the lights when leaving their bedroom	Drain the bathtub and put away towels after taking a bath
Hold the doors for other people, with the help from an adult	Carry dishes to the counter after eating	Help clean up messes like juice spills	Clean up toys after done playing with them	Learn how to make sure they are buckled correctly in their car seat	Push in their chair after leaving the table
Throw away any trash they have	Washing hands after each time they become soiled	Write their name on all papers that they create	Help wash the family cars	Help use the dustpan when an adult is sweeping	Greet people when coming into a room
